

Camera Features for various Apps

Introduction

The native camera app has many features but there's additional features that require use of a 3rd party app. The table below provides some features and the app that has them. Unless you have a special requirement, the native camera app will suit your purpose most of the time. Use the tables below as a guide. For example, if you want to try shooting and editing Raw photos, you'll need a 3rd party app.
