

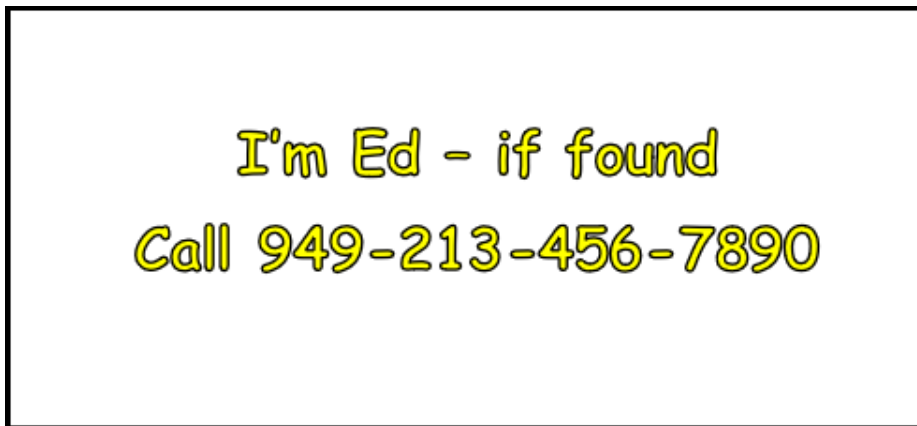
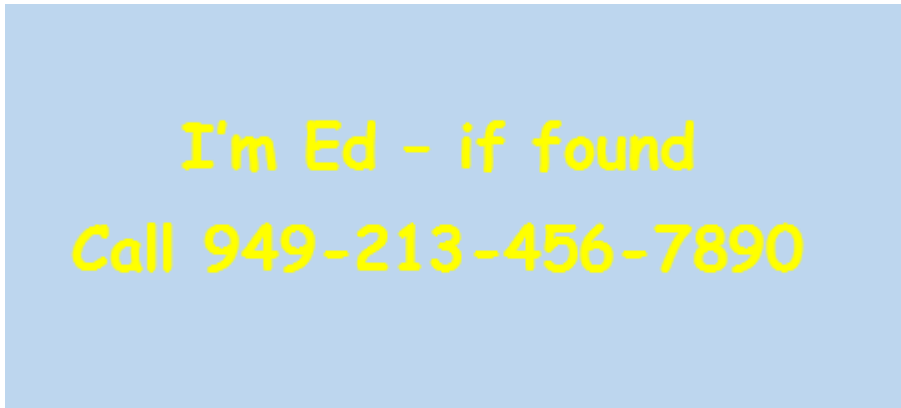
Creating Wallpaper

Introduction

The purpose of this is to have your Lock Screen show your information in case you lose your device

How to proceed

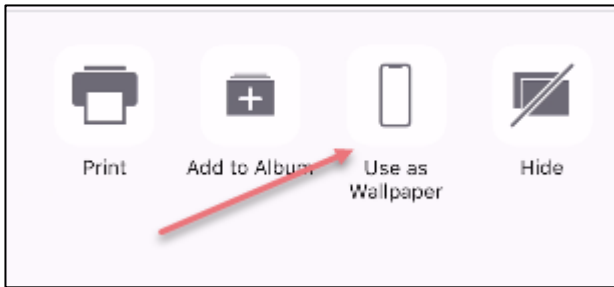
You can use any word processor such as Notepad or Word. Below are two examples with obvious differences. You can make yours as colorful as you want.



Here are the steps.

1. Open a word processor and type the information using at least a size 23 font
2. Take a photo of the document from the screen or from a printed version. Take two photos holding the camera in the portrait and vertical orientation and hold the camera close enough to the text so that it fills 1/2 of the screen. You may have to repeat this step until you get the results that you like.
3. Open the Photos app and tap one of the photos

4. Tap the Share icon and scroll to the right until you see Use as Wallpaper as shown below.



5. Tap Use as Wallpaper and position the image by moving and pinching until it looks correct. If it doesn't fit, try again with the other orientation.
6. Tap Set and then tap Set Lock Screen
7. Put your iPhone or iPad to sleep to test the Wallpaper. You might have to redo it a few times.
