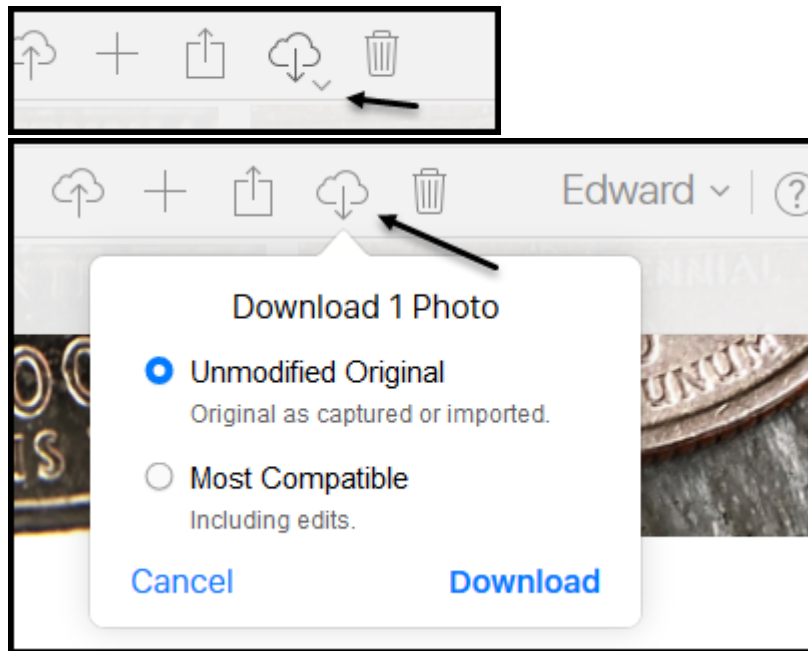

- For editing video with iMovie, the best way is to shoot video on an iPhone since it's easier to use, and edit the video on your iPad which has a larger screen.
- Transferring videos from an iPhone to an iPad
  - With iCloud Photo Library turned on the process is automatic
  - Without the iCloud Library you can use AirDrop

### Moving and transferring your photos or videos

- From your mobile device to your PC
  - To transfer photos without edits (originals), use the free [Syncios](#). See tutorial [here](#) and [here](#). You can also download photos from your online iCloud account.
  - To transfer photos with edits intact, use Simple Transfer. This app is free and runs on your mobile device. It will instruct you to open a browser and go to a special web address. You can see the app [here](#).
  - To learn more about transferring edited photos see the information [here](#).
  - You can also go to your iCloud account online to download photos. When you click the dropdown arrow under the cloud icon as shown in the figure below, you will get a choice of downloading the original (either an HEIC or Raw format) or Most Compatible (JPG format). You can download both if you choose. This is by far the best way to get photos from your mobile device to your PC.

- From your PC to your mobile devices
  - You can upload photos to your iCloud account and they will show up on your mobile devices. It's best to create an album on your device first. You can only upload the JPG format.
  - You can also use the app called Simple Transfer. It lets you create an album during the upload. This app will let you transfer HEIC photos as JPGs. Just go to Settings on the app and choose.
  - Even though you can use Syncios for this, I don't recommend it.
- From your memory card to your mobile device

### Deleting photos

- When you delete one or more photos either from your device or from your iCloud account online, they are removed from all your devices and removed from your iCloud online account.
- The deleted photos are moved to an album on your device named Recently Deleted where they remain for 30 days.

- From the Recently Deleted album they can be recovered up to 30 days from when they were deleted.
