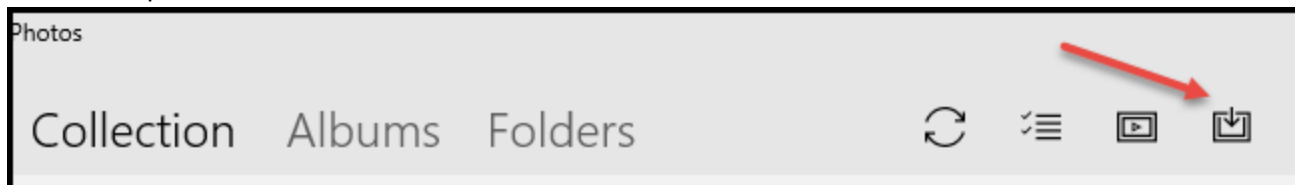
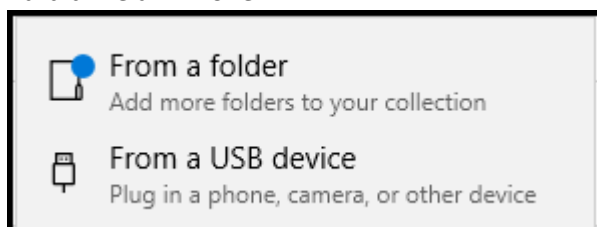


## Importing Photos with the Windows Photos App

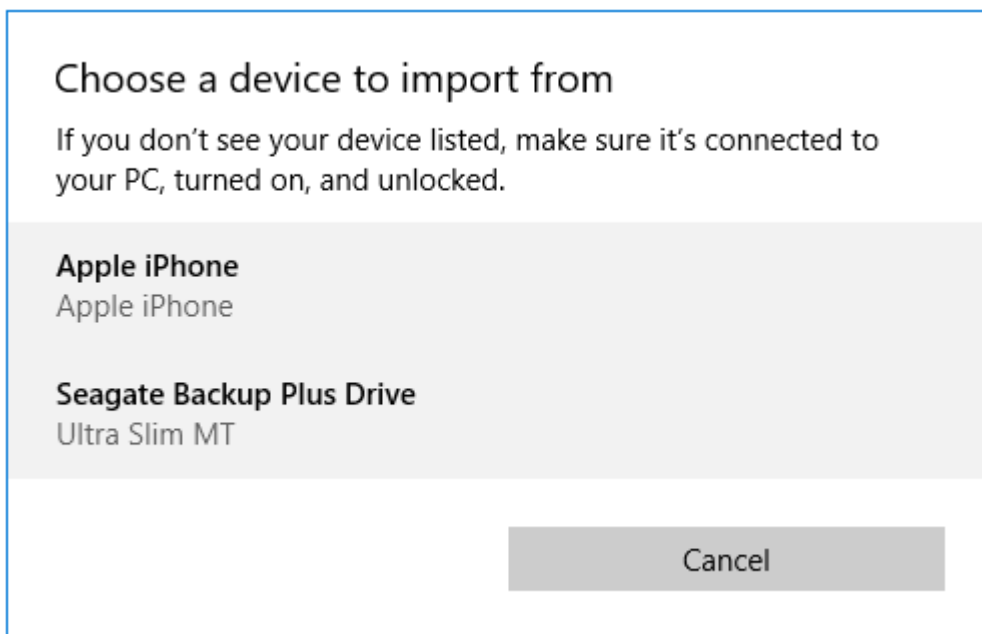
- Connect a mobile device, flash drive or memory card reader to your PC and close any windows that may pop up.
- Open the Photos App and make sure the Collection is selected
- Click the Import icon as shown below



- Make a choice from the menu that pops up as shown below In this case I've connected an external hard drive an iPhone.

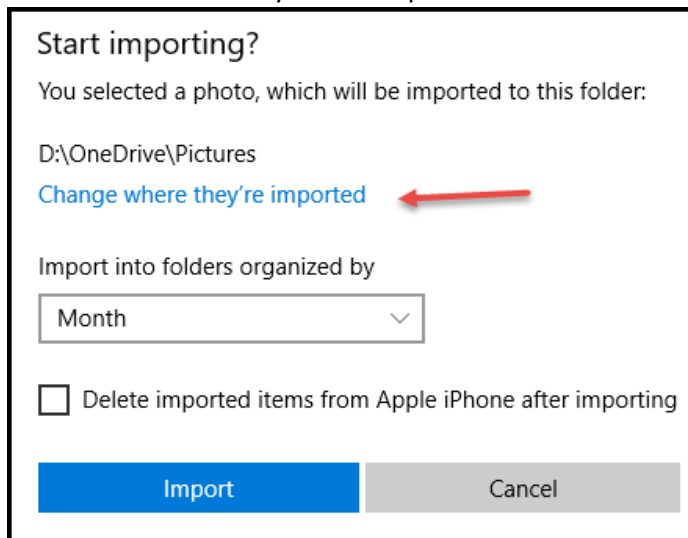


- Next, I clicked From a USB device and got the menu as shown below

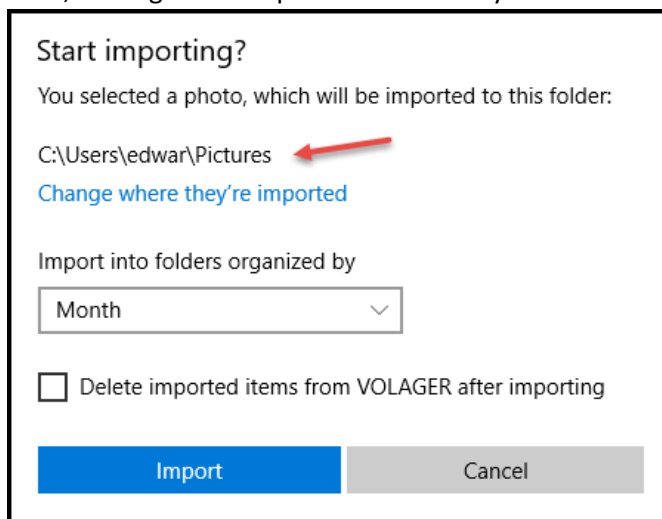


- Next, I clicked Apple iPhone. I got a big red X so I made sure to wake my iPhone and tap Allow. Next, I click Try again.
- This time it found my photos. From here you can select which photos to import. I clicked Unselect All and just chose the folders I wanted.
- Click Continue
- In the next screen click the Dropdown box to select by Month or Day.
- Click Import

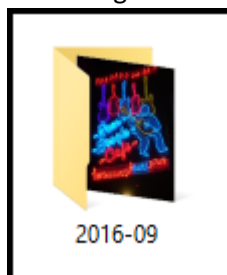
- Click Change where they're imported to determine the folder where they will be imported to as shown below. In this case they will be imported to OneDrive but you can change it.



- Next, I changed the import location to my Pictures folder as shown below



- The pictures showed up in a folder with a name containing the month that the photos were taken. You can change the name as desired. These photos were taken in September 11, 2016.



Note – if you want to reimport items, they might not show up. In this case click New items, then click Already imported and select the items that you want to reimport.
