

Editing photos and transferring them to your PC

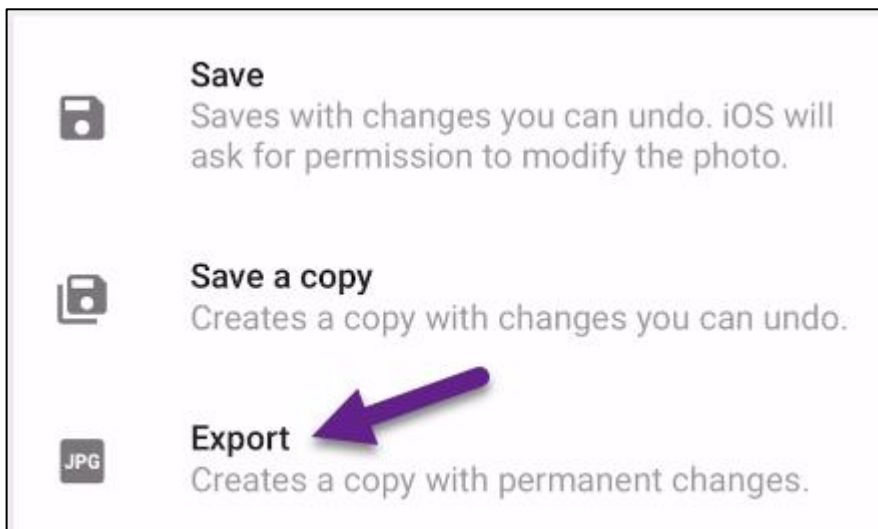
Introduction

There are basically 2 ways to edit photos on your mobile device, using the native Photos App or a 3rd party App. I've tried many apps but the best one is Snapseed which is free in the App Store. You can see it [here](#).

When using the native Photos App to edit photos, transferring the edited photos to your PC is not very easy. I've tried most photo transfer programs and they are all inconsistent. Some programs only transfer the originals and others only transfer the edited photos. Using the process outlined below, all the hassle is removed when you transfer edited photos.

Here are the details

1. Install the Snapseed App
2. Only edit photos in Snapseed. After editing, tap Export, and on the next screen tap Export again as shown below.



3. Snapseed creates an album in the Photos App making it easy to locate the edited photos
4. Install the free Syncios (available [here](#)) program on your Windows PC. You must install iTunes (available [here](#)) also for Syncios to work.
5. Connect your mobile device to your PC using a USB connection and run Syncios.
6. You can now transfer any or all photos to your PC. The edited photos will be in the album named Snapseed.
