

Using Windows File Explorer to transfer Photos

Introduction

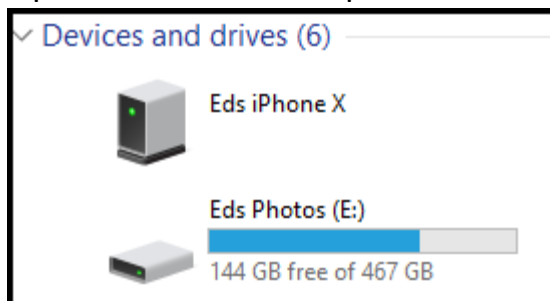
This simply transfers all the JPGs, HEICs, Raw photos and videos to your PC. They will be arranged into folders with silly names. You will have to explore these folders to find what you want. Live photos and videos you shot will be listed as a MOV file.

FYI – I had 540 photos and videos and it required 2 gigabytes of storage.

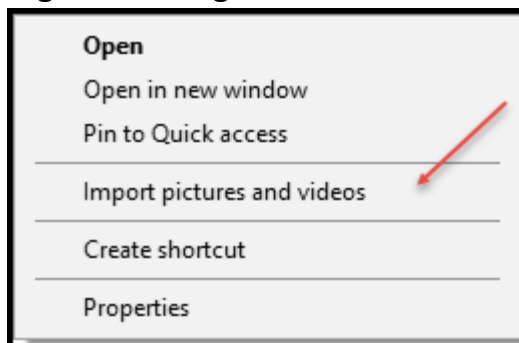
Windows File Explorer – this is not convenient, but it works. You can also transfer MOV

Here's how to use it.

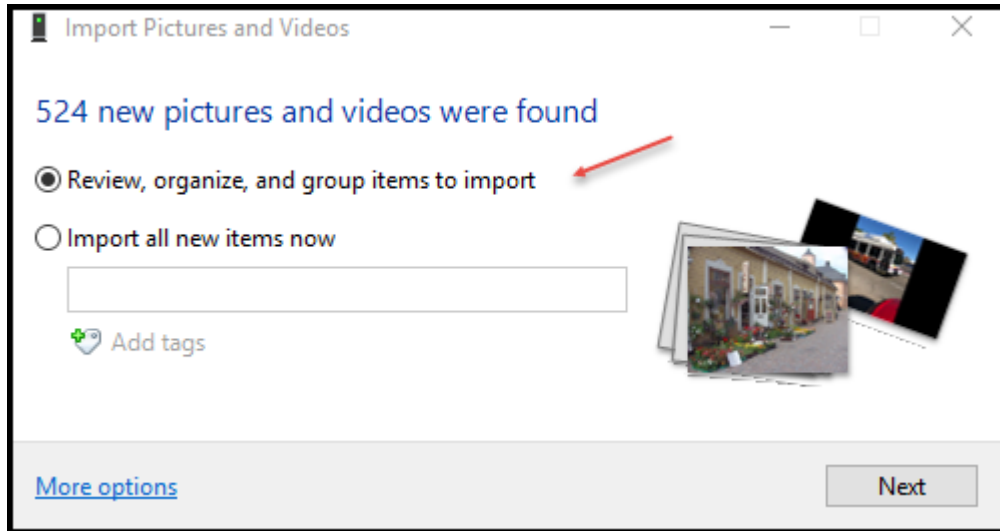
- Connect your device to your PC with a USB cable
- Close any windows that might pop up
- Open Windows File Explorer. You should see your device as shown below



- Wake and sign in on your device
- Right-click to get the choices as shown below.



- Click Import pictures and videos. Select the top choice as shown below.



- Click Next. From here you can start by clicking Select all at the top. Click it again if you just want to select a few.
- Click Import at the lower right.
- Your photos will show up in your Pictures folder. Here's how my folder looked.
