

Various ways to take a photo

1. Conventional method – press the shutter button on the camera app.
2. Use the volume up or down button.
3. Connect a headset and use the volume up or down button. This doesn't work with a Bluetooth headset.
4. Use a Bluetooth remote.
5. Use an Apple Watch if you have one.
6. Some 3rd party apps such as Pro Camera allow you to tap the screen to take a photo.
7. You can use your voice to take a photo with the VoiceSnap app.
8. There's a 3rd party app called Camera+ that will detect a smile after you press the shutter

How about Siri?

You can say "Hey, Siri Take a photo". The camera app will open but the shutter **will not fire**. This is where a Bluetooth remote or VoiceSnap comes in handy.

You can say:

- Take a picture
- Take a square picture
- Take a panoramic picture
- Take a selfie
- Take a video
- Take a slow-motion video
- Take a time-lapse video

Siri cannot:

- Fire the flash unless it's already enabled
- Take Live photo
- Turn on grid
