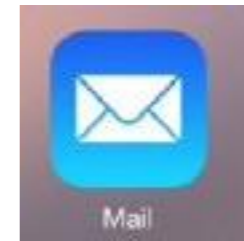
Use the Internet

- Bank, pay bills, make deposits



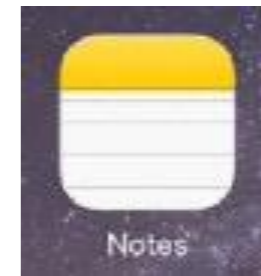
Use Email

- Schedule & sync reminders

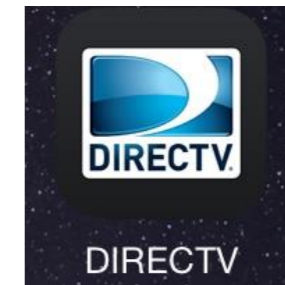


Use the App Store

Measure your Internet speed

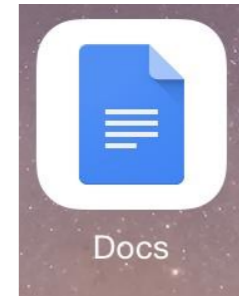
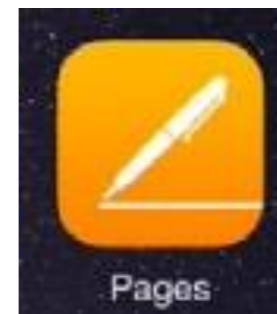
- Measure WiFi download & upload speed

Use Accessories

- Camera connection kit
- Cases and covers

Navigate

Use iTunes

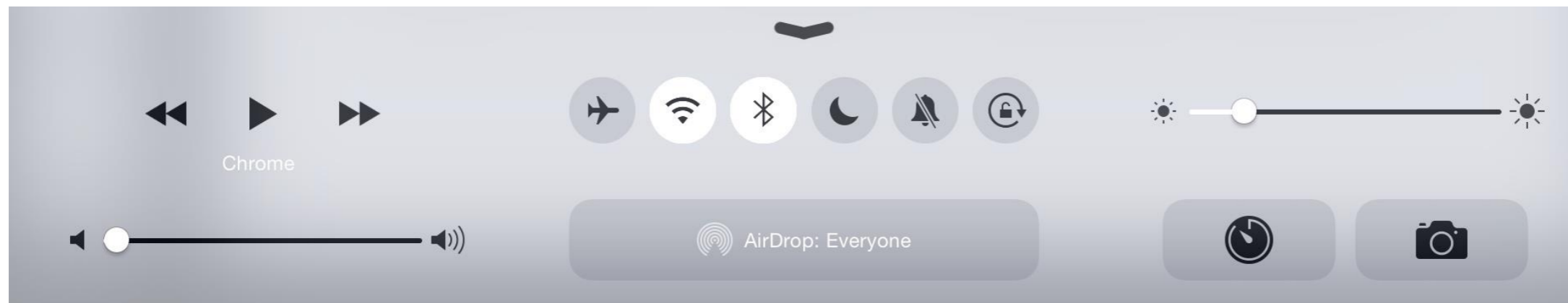
- Add content to your iPad
- Manage & Update Apps
- Back up your iPad
- Connect to iTunes store
- Play music

Use Gestures

- Swipe Up/Down to scroll
- Pinch to zoom
- Swipe side-to-side to Move Next / Previous
- Tap the top menu to move to top
- Swipe Down for Spotlight Search

Use Gestures cont.

- Swipe from top edge for Notifications
- Swipe from bottom edge for the Control Panel
- Swipe from left edge to move back (in Browser)



Things you can't do
