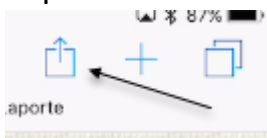
All the buttons and screens on the iPhone and iPad will be reviewed in the first class.

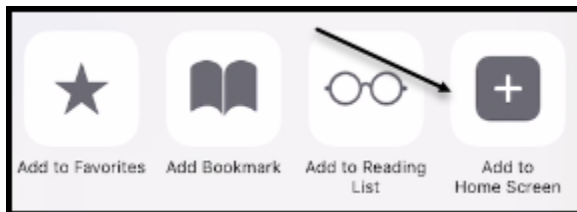
iOS 11 will be coming during September 2017. The changes are extensive and will be discussed as soon as it becomes available.

Add a shortcut to my web site to your Home screen

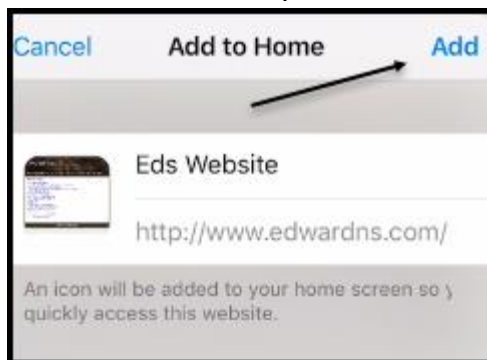
1. Make sure you're connected to Wi-Fi
2. Open Safari and go to www.edwardns.com
3. Tap iPad iPhone Class
4. Tap the Share icon at the top



5. Tap Add to Home Screen



6. Tap Add. This will place an icon on your Home screen



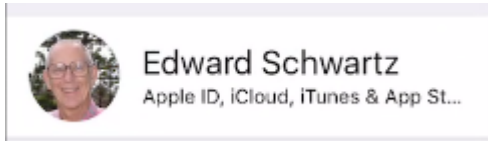
Important Settings

- Turn on Backup

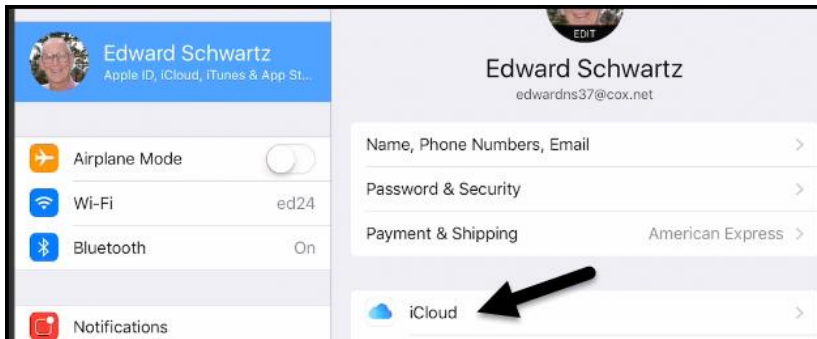
- On your iPhone or iPad go to Settings,



- Tap your name



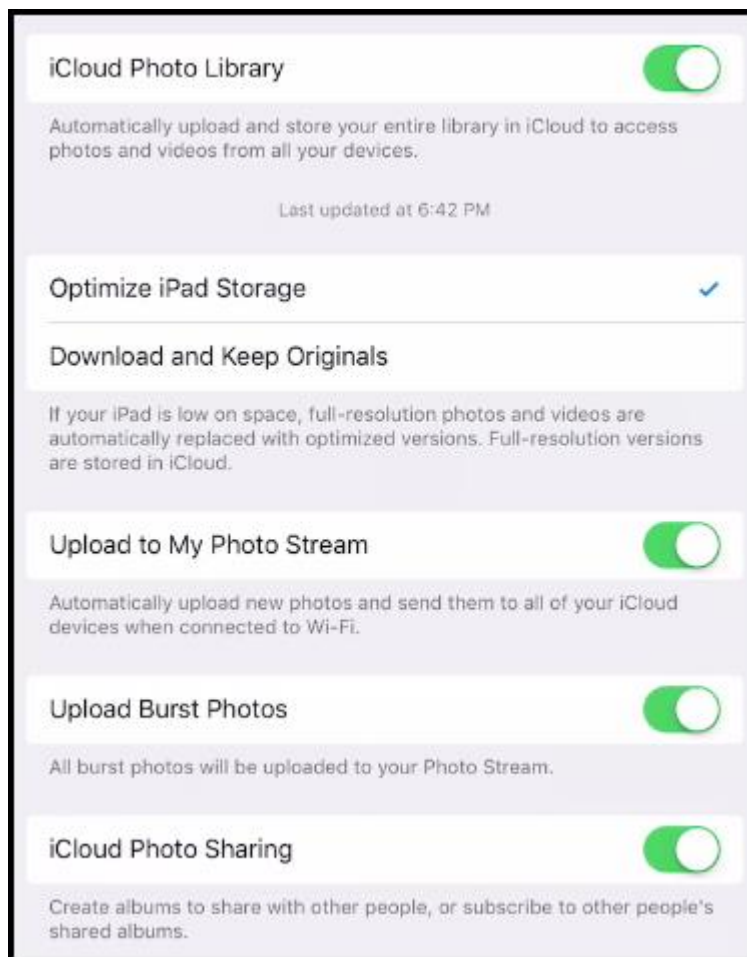
- Tap iCloud



- Scroll down to iCloud Backup and turn it on

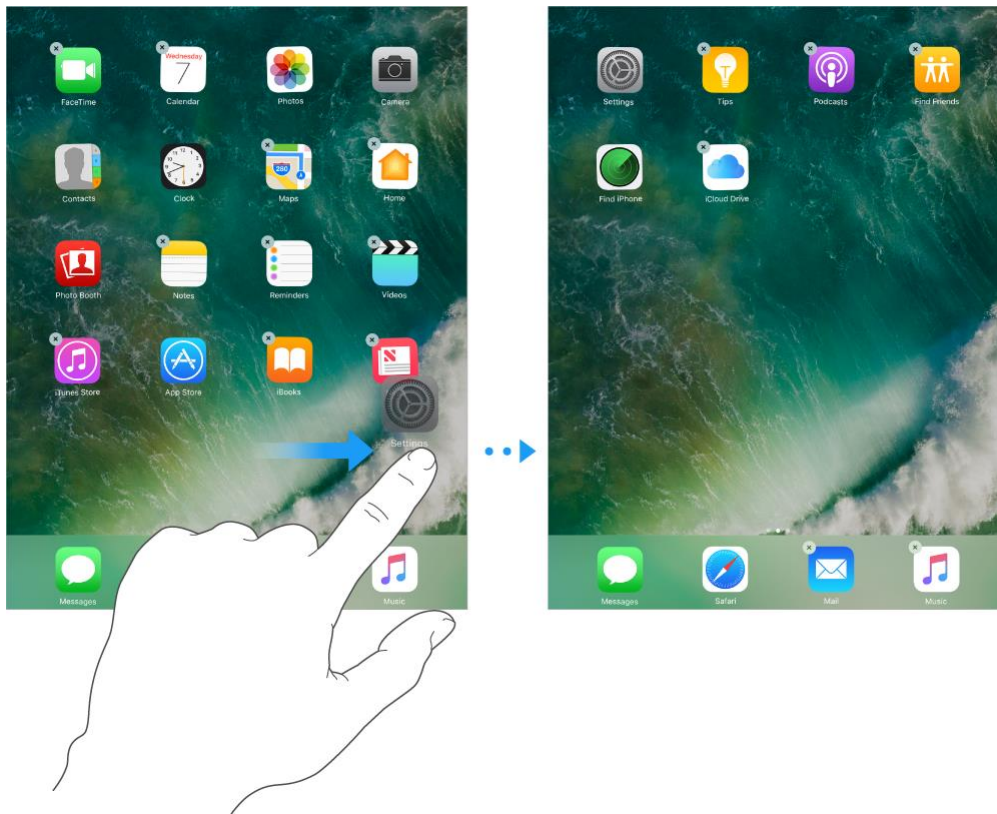


- Turn on iCloud Photo Library if you want to sync photo between devices and have photos backed up to iCloud
 - Go to Settings, iCloud as discussed above
 - Tap Photos and turn on the settings as shown below. These settings will be discussed further when we cover photos in Week 5.



Arrange your apps

Arrange apps. Touch and hold any app on the Home screen until you see the app icons jiggle, then drag apps around. Drag an app to the edge of the screen to move it to a different Home screen, or drag it to the Dock at the bottom of the screen (you may need to remove another app first). Press the Home button to save your arrangement.

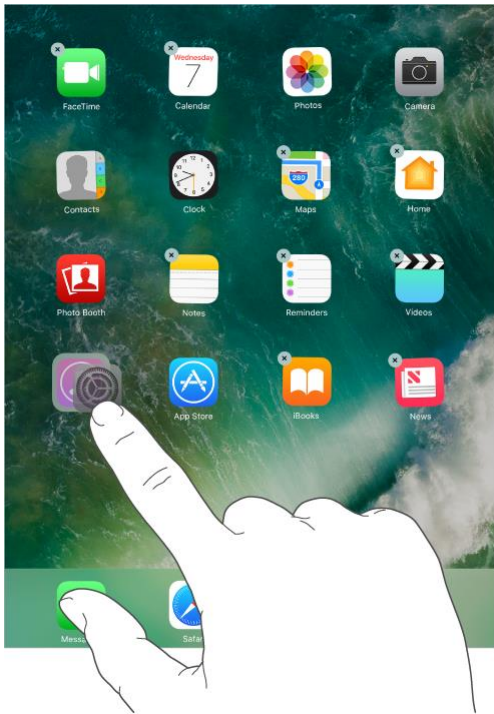


Create a new Home screen. While arranging apps, drag an app to the right edge of the last Home screen. The dots above the Dock show which of your Home screens you're viewing.

Start over. Go to Settings > General > Reset, then tap Reset Home Screen Layout to return the Home screen and apps to their original layout. Any folders you've created are removed, the original wallpaper is restored, and apps you've downloaded are placed after apps that came with your iPad.

Organize with folders


Create a folder. While arranging apps, drag one app onto another. Tap the name of the folder to rename it. Drag apps into or out of the folder. Press the Home button when you finish.



You can have multiple pages of apps in a folder.

Delete a folder. Drag out all the apps—the folder is deleted automatically.

Remove apps

Remove apps from the Home screen. Touch and hold an app on the Home screen until you see the app icons jiggle, then tap  in the upper-left corner. When you finish, press the Home button.
