

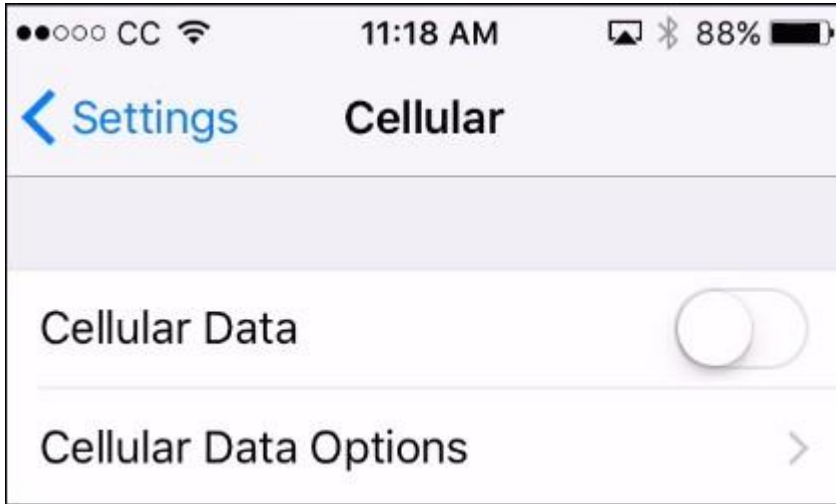
Important iPhone Settings

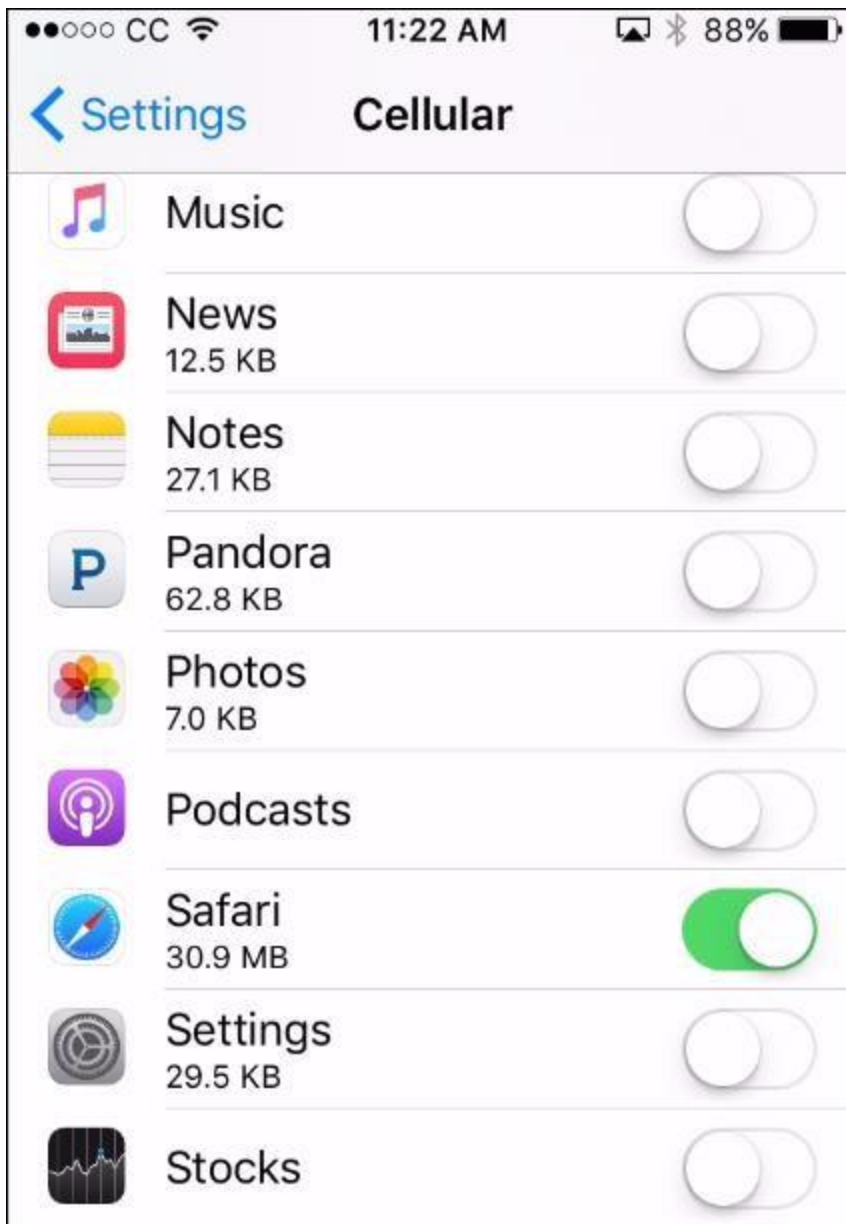

Cellular Data Settings

If you don't have unlimited data, you may want to turn Cellular Data off. Go to Settings and tap Cellular. Next, set it to Off.



Also, if you have Cellular Data On and don't open any Apps, you will continue to use Data since some Apps run in the background. You can stop this from happening by first, turning on Cellular Data and scrolling down. Here you will see all your Apps where you can stop them from using Cellular Data.



For example, I enable Safari as you can see above. This allow me to be in a store, turn on my Cellular Data, and look something up.

iCloud Settings

I like to use the iCloud Photo Library so I enable his feature. To read more about it go to <http://www.edwardns.com/apple-resources/> and look for links titled iCloud Photo Library. To turn it on, go to Settings, iCloud Photos as shown below.



You can also turn on Optimize iPhone Storage. This prevents you iPhone from filling up do to too many photos.
